### **Sec. 226(1)(b) Incontestable Period**

If statements, other than those relating to age and identity, are required as a condition to issuing the contract, a provision that the contract shall be incontestable after it has been in force during the lifetime of the person or each of the persons as to whom such statements are required, for a period of two years from its date of issue, except where stipulated payments to the company have not been made and except for violations of the conditions of the contract relating to military or naval service in time of war and except, at the option of the company, with respect to provisions relative to benefits in the event of total and permanent disability and provisions which grant insurance specifically against death by accident.
