ACTUARIAL OPINION SUMMARY FILINGS (CB 2013-15)

This bulletin supersedes CB 2009-1 regarding the Actuarial Opinion Summary (AOS) filing requirements of 215 ILCS 5/136(6)(a).

Effective with the yearend 2008 filing, all companies authorized to write property and/or casualty insurance in Illinois must submit an AOS consistent with the NAIC Annual Statement Instructions for an Actuarial Opinion Summary Supplement.

The AOS for Illinois domestic companies shall be submitted annually by March 15th for the preceding year. Each foreign and alien company authorized to do business in Illinois shall provide the AOS upon written request from the Illinois Department of Insurance. If requested by the Department, then the AOS should be sent within fifteen days of the request, but no earlier than March 15th.

Pursuant to 215 ILCS 136(6)(d) and NAIC Annual Statement Instructions, the AOS is considered a confidential document and therefore should not be sent in with the annual statement, but should be stamped "confidential" and submitted electronically to DOI.PCActExam@Illinois.gov to the attention of:
